Visa

- Anyone who is not a Maldivian needs a valid visa to enter and spend time in Maldives.
- All visas must be obtained before travelling
- Type of Visa required to attend the conference: Business Visa

Business visa is the permit to remain in the Maldives for a specific period of time, granted to a foreign national visiting the Maldives. This visa is issued for the purposes of doing a business or a professional work that has been permitted and approved by the concerned Maldivian Government authority.

Climate and Time Zone

Climate

The Maldives benefits due to its location near the Equator, which offers stable temperatures throughout the year and protection from cyclones. The climate is tropical equatorial, generally humid and warm with 2 seasons called Monsoons.

Hot and dry, the winter monsoon in Maldives, named "Iruvai" in Dhivehi (Maldivian language), generally begin around October/November

Rainy and Windy, the summer monsoon in Maldives, named "Hulhangu" in Dhivehi (Maldivian language), often starts around May and reaches its peak around July / August.

Air temperature

Highest air temperature / Dry season : between 30°C/32°C (86°-90F°)

Lowest air temperature / Rainy season : between 25°C/28°C (77°-83F°)

Sea Temperature

Highest sea temperature: 35°C (95F°)

Lowest sea temperature: 24°C (75F°)

Time Zone

The Maldives Standard Time is 5 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+5).

* Does not operate daylight-Saving Time





Velana International Airport is the main international Airport in the Maldives. It is located on Hulhule Island in the North Male' Atoll, near the capital island Male'.

Immigration Arrival Forms

Prior to landing in Maldives you will be handed an Immigration form to fill out. The form will be available from the immigration counter as well.

Transportation

Airport Ferry offers regular transfers between Male' Airport and Male' city. Speedboat transfers to Male' city and nearby resorts are available from the Airport.

Airport bus offers regular transfers between Airport and Hulhumale' every 30 minutes.

There are two exchange counters one at the arrival terminal and the other at 1st floor departure terminal for passengers convenience. An ATM machine is located just near the arrival exit gates at the arrival plaza area. Major credit cards such as Visa, Master and American Express are accepted throughout the Maldives.

Islamic Centre

- The Islamic Centre (officially named Masjid-al-Sultan Muhammad Thakurufaanu Al Auzam) is an architectural landmark in Malé, <u>Maldives</u> opened in November 1984 by President Maumoon Abdul Gayoom.
- The Grand Friday Mosque located in the Centre is named after the one of the most celebrated Maldivian heroes, Sultan Muhammad Thakurufaanu Al Auzam of the Maldives. The mosque is the largest in the Maldives, and also one of the largest in South Asia, admitting over 5,000 people.
